Carrie Shubert certainly has had an amazing life. At four years old, Carrie realized that she felt different and apart from other children. She spent many evenings staring at the stars and longing to go home, as if home was some other planet. Growing up in Cleveland, Ohio, Carrie's mentors were Jeannie from "I Dream of Jeannie", Samantha Stevens from "Bewitched", and Uncle Martin from "My Favorite Martian". These early observations combined with a witty sense of humor would soon form the foundation for Carrie's entire life's journey.

Subsequent to the Northridge earthquake, Carrie relocated to Scottsdale, Arizona where she runs a successful practice as a clairvoyant/psychic consultant, lecturer, teacher, author, medium, and certified hypnotherapist.

Carrie believes that her psychic ability is a spiritual gift meant to promote joy, not fear. As a rule, Carrie blends humor with insight to connect to those people she reads. She uses what she calls a "light approach", to help restore faith and hope in those that she touches. Carrie has found this approach to be most effective when dealing with people who are attempting to resolve painful issues, specifically around feelings of loss.

In March of 2003, Carrie released her first book, *Living in the Third Dimensional Soap Opera...A Spiritual Guide to Sanity*, a guide book combining spiritual, metaphysical, and psychological thoughts to give the reader a deeper perspective on

life. The book offers simple concepts that are easy to apply and which will take the edge off of day-to-day living.

Carrie currently teaches these concepts and others in private workshops as well as at the college level. Her class entitled, "Developing Your Psychic Abilities" continues to be a perennial favorite for students continuing their educations. She has worked in this field for the past 24 years.

Throughout her career, Carrie has appeared on both national television and radio programs including NBC Talk Show Kelly & Gail, KNXV ABC 15 in Phoenix's Sonoran Living, KMLE-FM and KTAR-AM in Phoenix, nationally syndicated radio show with Peter Weissbach, and internet-based talk show, Shrink Wrap.

Additionally, she has hosted a psychic series for the United Artists cable television network. She has been a regular on KZON-FM and KXAM-AM in Arizona. And most recently, she hosted an internet radio show on voiceamerica.com.

In addition to her private practice and teaching her workshops, Carrie has been an active participant in a twelve-step program for the past 22 years as well as has volunteered her time to both national and local authorities in helping to solve crimes and find missing persons. She has also worked with bereavement groups including Mother's in Sympathy and Support (M.I.S.S) by offering counseling when needed.
