My husband and I would like to share our experiences that we have had with our friend, psychic and medium, Carrie Shubert. I first heard Carrie on the radio in 1998, and found her fascinating to listen to. I had always been a little curious about psychic readings, but never had the nerve to pursue it. However, Carrie's humor, and especially her laugh, really came through and something started to nag me to call for an appointment with her. For that first reading, I was very nervous about what she would tell me, and how much would really be accurate. On the way to my appointment that day, I was trying to decide if I really wanted to ask any questions about my father, or did I really want to know? (My father has chronic health problems) By the time I had arrived, I had decided to not ask any questions about my father, thinking that I may not be able to handle the answers. But...as soon as Carrie got into 'my channel', and before I even said one word, she said that she was hearing two names, "Bob" and "Scott". (Bob is my father's name; Scott was my then-boyfriend-now-husband's name!) So right in that moment, I knew Carrie was legit. In that first reading, she said so many things that I recognized, but that I was still curious about. So I booked Scott for a reading to see if the things she had seen for me would match up with what she saw for Scott! (They did.) From that point on, we have been huge fans of Carrie Shubert and get a yearly reading.

Carrie has been especially appreciated in times of stress. In 2002, our newborn daughter came with us for one of our readings and Carrie was able to 'read' her as well. (That was really neat!) And of course, she saw her growing up and as an adult. Well, a few months later, our little girl got very, very sick. The doctors were telling us that she wasn't going to make it. I frantically called Carrie and wanted to know if somehow my daughter had "jumped the track". Carrie did everything she could to verify what she had seen when she read my daughter at only 3 weeks old. One thing that she said was that we were in for a long, bumpy road, but our daughter would be fine in the end. And for two weeks, the doctors ran multiple random tests that put us on an emotional rollercoaster. Carrie let us call her every day with the latest updates. I felt like I was 'bothering' her, but I always felt better after the calls. Our daughter is five years old now, and doing relatively well.

We still have plenty of health and financial issues that we worry about, and when we just can't get to the 'calm rational place', we put in a call to Carrie. Not just for her psychic ability, but more for her comforting way of putting things in a spiritual perspective. For myself, I think that I have grown a lot spiritually since my first reading with Carrie. When things get too stressful, I try to remember some of the things Carrie has said: "God is the Director", "If something is *supposed* to happen, it will and you can't screw it up. But if something is *not supposed* to happen, it doesn't matter how hard you try, you will not make it work." This has really helped.

We have recommended Carrie to several of our friends and family over the years. My husband and I feel very blessed and lucky to have her in our lives!
